2014 Book Scheme and Technology Levy

Welcome to Gaven State School!

On enrolment at our school the Book Resource Scheme and the Technology Support Levy will be explained to you. Below is a summary of these:

1. Book Resource Scheme

The 2014 Book Resource Scheme cost is \$120 per child. This includes all books, pencils, text books and other stationery supplies for the year. As the year progresses the cost per child is altered accordingly:

Term 1 enrolment: \$120 (\$80 and then 2 x \$20 Payments in terms 2 & 3)

Term 2 enrolment: \$90 (entire amount required)

Term 3 & 4 enrolment: \$60 (to cover the text book costs)

The Book Resource Scheme **Participation Agreement Form** must be completed and returned to the school office

2. Technology Support Levy

The 2014 Technology Support Levy cost is \$100 per child and \$80 per child for siblings. This voluntary levy is to support the continual costs involved with ICT such as upgrades and purchase of computers, iPads and wireless internet. The school has also funded each student for the online Mathletics program.

Term 1 enrolment: \$100 (\$80 for each extra sibling)

Term 2 enrolment: \$75 (\$55 for each extra sibling)

Term 3 & 4 enrolment: \$50 (\$30 for each extra sibling)

After 24 hours the enrolment will be processed. Monetary payments can occur after this time as follows:

1. If you are using a credit card or debit card (EFTPOS), cash, cheque or money order this can be paid directly through the money window at the administration office on **Wednesday and Friday 8.15-10.00am ONLY**. No money is accepted on other days.
2. Internet Payment – This can be made at any time (after the 24 hours for the enrolment process) and can be paid via a direct payment into the school bank account.
